Scholarship Criteria: Whether or not any scholarships are awarded in a given year is at the sole discretion of the MRA Board of Directors. No more that two (2) scholarships will be given in any year. Scholarships, when given, will be awarded at the Association's Annual Meeting in October. Awards will be based on a "points system" based on the following: (a) the applicant's high school grade point average (GPA) multiplied by 100 plus (b) their SAT score plus (c) 15 points added for a child of an MRA member, 10 points added for a grandchild; and 5 points for a niece/nephew plus (d) 15 points added for a student who provided volunteer time on behalf of the Association plus (e) 10 points added if the student is a member of the MRA Juniors' Shooting Program.
